

Enrichment



In English this term we will be focusing on retrieving information from a variety of texts. Our writing will see us creating character descriptions and writing a report.



In Maths we will be focusing on place value and the meaning of digits and number. We will also be using the four operations $+ - \times /$ in our 6 a day.



In science we will be learning about sound as vibrations. We will be looking at the different pitch different objects make, how sound travels, how the human ear works and recognising the sounds we hear



We will be learning about the internet. We will be looking at Online Safety how children can stay safe online.



This term we will be focusing on Hinduism and about what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today.

Enrichment
