ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English we will be focusing on <i>Greek Myths</i>. We will be creating our own mythical creatures and writing about them. We will also be learning our High Frequency Words for Year 3 and practising our handwriting.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>This term we will be focusing on place value and the meaning of digits and number. We will be adding and subtracting up to 3 digit numbers. We will be using all four operations in our 6 A Day challenges.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>During this term in Science, we will be looking at light and shadows and how they are formed. We will start to understand how light enables us to see but also how some light, like the sun, can be dangerous.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>In ICT we will be focusing on how to log on and access our <i>Google Classroom</i> accounts as well as looking at computing systems and networks.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today? We will be looking at how Christianity is celebrated throughout Britain and how people show their faith in different ways.</p>

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>In <i>Gods and Mortals</i> we will be looking at Ancient Greece. We will identify Greece using maps and atlases as well as learning about what life was like in Ancient Greek times, including investigating all about the Greek gods.</p>
<p>MUSIC</p> 	<p>Year 3 will be focus their learning around one song: <i>Let Your Spirit Fly</i>. This unit will look at the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc). Children will continue to listen and appraise the music.</p>
<p>DT/Art</p> 	<p>In art we will be looking at using different sketching skills and we will be creating different pencil drawings based on ancient Greek artifacts, thinking about shading techniques.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Year 3 will be having a Sports Coach teach every Thursday. This term we will be looking at ball skills, coordination, moving and catching and the fundamentals of PE on Fridays.</p>
<p>MFL</p> 	<p>Year 3 will be starting their MFL journey with Spanish. We will look at the alphabet, numbers, counting and basic greetings.</p>
