ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING	
English	In reading this term we will be focusing on skills needed for answering questions linked to our text "The Beetle Boy". In writing, we will be writing to inform using a non-chronological report and to entertain/inform as a recount.
Maths	In Maths we will be focusing on decimals and percentages and learning their equivalence with fractions. We will be comparing, ordering and rounding decimals. We will be finding the perimeter of rectangles, rectilinear shapes and polygons and calculating the area of rectangle and compound shapes.
Science	During the term we will be learning about 'Living Things and their habitats'. We will learn about reproduction in plants, flowering plants and animals. We will observe and compare the life cycles of animals. We will collect and classify minibeasts and identify their homes and habitats.
Computing	This term we will learn about 'Programming - selection in physical computing. We will learn how to connect and program components.


Geography



Art
