ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

English	In writing, this term we will be exploring and writing a fable based on Native Americans' stories. We will explore the purpose of a dialogue in the story and develop our understanding of past progressive tense.
Maths ⊕□ ∷	In Maths, we will be consolidating our understanding of fractions. We will be learning about mixed numbers and improper fractions as well as learning how to convert between the two. We will also be learning about perimeter and length.
Science	In Science this term, we will be looking at electricity and the differences between batteries and mains electricity. We will be investigating circuits, how they work and what happens if there is a part of the circuit missing
