### **Reading**

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p>In English, our texts for this term are <i>The Secret Sky Garden</i> and <i>My first Gardening Book</i>. We will be using these texts to write a diary entry and instructions. We will learn the different features required of these genres and use what we have learnt to write our own diary entry and set of instructions.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In maths, we will be learning how to measure in centimetres, metres, grams and kilograms. We will learn how to compare and order different lengths, heights and weights, as well as using maths operations to solve a range of different questions around these. We will also begin to practise using fractions (half, quarters and thirds).</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>In science, we will be learning about plants. We will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants by carrying out experiments throughout the term. We will also be finding out and describing how plants grow and stay healthy by ensuring they have water, light and a suitable temperature.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>In computing this term, we will be exploring data, representing and analysing data and how to use pictograms.</p>
<p><b>D E</b></p> 	<p>In RE, we will be thinking about how we should care for others and the world around us and why this matters within three different religions.</p>

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>Geography</b></p> 	<p>In geography, we will be learning about vegetation and fauna in different countries around the world. We will also be exploring the weather, different climates and when they are at their most extreme.</p>
<p><b>Music</b></p> 	<p>Friendship Song is a song about being friends. It teaches us about friendship - How are we kind to our friends? Are we kind to new people that come to our school? Embracing the fact that we are all different and knowing that that is brilliant - Let's celebrate that! Learning how to be respectful of one another, wherever we are from, wherever we live and whomever we love.</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p> 	<p>In art, we will be exploring how music and media can influence artistic expression. The children will learn how to pace their focus and drawing skills to the sound metronome. The children will also learn how different sounds can represent different colours through studying the work of Wassily Kandinsky.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>In this unit, pupils develop their understanding of the principles of defending (fielding) and attacking (batting) when playing softball. They will use and develop skills such as throwing and catching, tracking a ball and striking a ball. They will learn how to score points, how to play to the rules and use simple tactics. They will learn the importance of showing respect towards others when playing competitively and develop communication skills.</p>
