Class Text

Reading

All children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home. Children will bring a reading record home so they can track their reading and share this with you. We would appreciate it if you could sign this off each week and talk to your child about what they are reading.





PE

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English, we will be exploring narrative poetry. We will read a selection of narrative poems, identify their features, imitate a famous poem and then apply the skills we have practised when we write our own narrative poem.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be continuing to look at decimals and multiplying and dividing them by 10, 100 and 1000. We will be looking at converting metric and imperial units and comparing an estimating volume. We will also revisit long multiplication and division.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>We will be learning about the life process and reproduction of animals, including humans. This ties into the PSHE topic of 'Changing Me'. We will also think about the timeline of our own lives.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>We will be developing our knowledge of selection by revisiting how conditions can be used in programs. We will represent this understanding in algorithms and then by constructing programs using the Scratch programming environment.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>We are going to learn about the history and geography of Bretton and surrounding areas. We will look at old photographs and discover how much Bretton has changed over ours and our parents lives.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>In RE, we are continuing to look at why some people believe God exists. We will learn about what Christians, Muslims and Jews believe and what different people believe about God.</p>
<p>D.T/ Art</p> 	<p>In Art, we will create self portraits using a mix of colours, based on the work of Andy Warhol. We will also use a range of mixed media to create self portraits, including manipulating print to edit their self portraits.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE will focus on developing teamwork skills through completed of a number of challenges. We will be working individually, collaboratively in pairs and groups to solve problems.</p>
