Enrichment

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English this term, we will be focusing on punctuation, handwriting and sentence structure. We will be looking at narrative writing using the text the Arrival by Shaun Tan. We will be focusing on using descriptive language and time conjunctions and adverbials.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be focusing on area and multiplication and division. We will also be focussing on teaching the gaps in multiplication in preparation for the multiplication check.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>In Science, we will be learning about electricity and how it has powered change in Britain. We will be constructing a simple series electrical circuit.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>We will be creating a program that uses count- controlled loops to design and write a program.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>This term, we will be focusing on Incarnation and what is the most significant part of the Nativity for Christmas?</p>

Enrichment

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>In Geography and History we will answering the question; Changing Peterborough: How has our city evolved since 1066? We will be looking at how national and global influences have shaped life in Peterborough We will be looking at photos and maps to compare how industries and migration have also changed our City.</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>This term, we will be learning to play a range of different songs using the Glockenspiel focussing on D,E and F</p>
<p>DT/Art</p> 	<p>In Design and Technology we will be using our new skills in science to create a torch and in art we will be looking at the architecture of buildings in Peterborough</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>This term, in PE we will be focussing on the skills of Tag-Rugby. We will learn to evade and tag opponents while keeping control of the rugby ball. Also how to pass the ball accurately and receive the ball safely and to apply learned skills in a game of tag rugby.</p>
