Class Text

Reading

All children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home. Please ensure that your child is reading regularly at home, and talk with them about what they have read. Books will be changed when children have completed an Accelerated Reading Quiz.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English this term, we will be focusing on discussion of themes and questioning of characters' motives and author's intent when looking at our class text (The Wolf Wilder) and other fiction and non-fiction extracts. Our writing will focus on a narrative that builds tension and argument writing.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will focus on fractions (comparing, ordering, calculating and finding fractions of amounts) as well as continuing to develop a range of reasoning and arithmetic skills. If your child is still unsure of their times table facts, please encourage them to practise regularly at home.</p>
	<p>During the term, the children will be learning about classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics and understanding how the system of classification was developed by Carl Linnaeus.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>We will be looking at internet communication. This unit begins with internet searching, refining searches, how searches are ranked. We then look at how we use the internet to communicate and how to do this safely and responsibly.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography</p> 	<p>We will be studying Alaska, learning about key aspects of the physical and human geography of the state and the impact of humans on this environment. We will also discuss climate and climate change, including steps humans can take to reduce their environmental impact.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>In RE this half term, we will be focusing on Buddhism - looking at The Buddha's life and the meaning of enlightenment.</p>
<p>Art</p> 	<p>During this term, the children will focus on perspective and painting. We will practise creating perspective using a vanishing point in our work.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE will focus on fitness this half term. Children will learn about different aspects of fitness and how a range of activities can help them to improve each of these.</p>
