Reading

The children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home. The children will have a levelled reader that will be changed weekly. ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In reading we will focus on developing comprehension skills by answering questions linked to the text we have read. Our writing will be focused on developing sentence structure by using interesting vocabulary, including adjectives and expanded noun phrases. We will be writing more complex sentences using conjunctions to extend our ideas.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be developing our multiplication and division skills and learning to apply these skills to problem solving tasks. We will also be looking at money, recognising notes and coins and learning to add and subtract amounts including finding change.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>During this half term, we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will investigate how plants and animals adapt to their habitats and learn about different food chains in various habitats.</p>
<p>Computin</p> 	<p>This half term we will develop our understanding of programming. We will be creating simple algorithms and programs to enable us to move floor robots. We will also be covering e-safety throughout the term.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geograph</p> 	<p>In Geography, we will continue to use maps, atlases and globes in order to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will also identify the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>This term we will learning about the Jewish faith. We will explore some of the objects that might be found in a Jewish home and how they link to daily life. We will also look at key celebrations such as Shabbat and Chanukkah.</p>
<p>DT</p> 	<p>In DT we will be exploring balanced diets. We will recap on our knowledge of food groups before identifying the balance of food groups within a meal. We will then taste test different foods from these groups and design our own wraps to make and test.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>In PE we will be exploring dance. We will explore travelling actions, movement skills and balancing. We will also learn why it is important to count to music and how to use this in our dances.</p>
