### **Class Text**

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p>This half term we will be using drama for writing to explore narratives. We will focus on securing foundational skills by writing a sequence of sentences in the third person to retell key story events. We will also introduce direct speech, using inverted commas correctly. Additionally, we will study poetry, writing sentences to describe personal thoughts and feelings before composing our own poems.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In Maths we will consolidate our knowledge of multiplication and division facts. In Year 3, we will look at representations for the 2, 3, 5, 4 &amp; 8 times tables. In Year 4, we will begin to use different strategies to solve multiplication and division of 3 &amp; 4 digit numbers.</p>
	<p>In Science, we will be learning about the different types of rocks. We will look at comparing and sorting them into groups (igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic).</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>During our computing lessons we explore 'Project Evolve' program to consolidate our knowledge about online safety.</p>

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>History</b></p> 	<p>In History we will continue to look at everyday life in the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will explore the tools and weapons they used as well as their settlements, homes, food, lifestyle and clothing.</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>In RE, we will investigate how and why people pray. We will explore similarities and differences between how Christians, Muslims and Hindus pray and consider the significance of prayers in the lives of people today.</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p> 	<p>In art we will be focusing on drawing. We will be developing shading skills and drawing techniques to create botanical-inspired digital drawings. Our key artist this half term is Dale Chihuly.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>In Dance, pupils will use movement to explore themes and express ideas, focusing on rhythm and coordination. During Gymnastics, the children will develop their core strength and balance by mastering various shapes, rolls, and sequences.</p>
