Reading

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English this term we will be focusing on developing our fluency, stamina and ability to share responses about texts we are reading. Our writing will focus on diary entries, narrative and poetry.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be learning about ratio and proportion, fractions, decimals and percentages. If your child is still unsure of their times table facts, please encourage them to practise regularly at home.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>We will be learning about light and reflection, comparing sources of light and explain how the eye is protected. We will also describe how light travels and how we see.</p>
<p>History</p> 	<p>We will be looking at an overview of ancient civilisations, understanding when they were in history, where in the world they were based and what their legacy has been.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>In this unit, we will develop our knowledge and understanding of using a computer to produce 3D models. We will go on to plan, develop and evaluate our own 3D model using the Tinkercad program.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Music</p> 	<p>This half term we will be developing ensemble skills. We will play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using voices and playing instruments. This will include improvising and composing music and listening with attention.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>In RE this term, we will continue to focus on Buddhism - looking at The Buddha's life and the meaning of enlightenment.</p>
<p>DT</p> 	<p>During this term, we will focus on DT in our unit about playground structures. We will create designs for apparatus, use available materials to make structures from our plans and evaluate how well they meet our design criteria..</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE will focus on dance and gymnastics this half term. We will learn about shape, movement and transitions. Lessons will look to improve building strength, flexibility and balance.</p>
