As the weather gets warmer, please still ensure that your child brings a coat and has wellington boots in school every day.

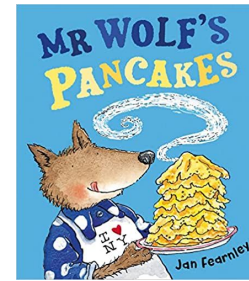
Please make sure your child has a spare bag of clothes on their peg, this is in case they get wet in the water tray.




ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Phonics 	In Phonics this half term, we will be consolidating our phase 3 phonemes, and practising applying them in longer words. Please look back at last terms homework in your child's phonic book and practice these at home. Children will access phonics in whole class sessions every morning and again at the end of the day.
Literacy 	We will look at a range of traditional tales such as; The Gingerbread Man, Chicken Licken and The 3 Little Pigs. Within our sessions we will look at building sentences, using a capital letter and a full stop.
Maths 	In Maths, we will be using the White Rose Maths scheme; 'Alive in 5, growing 6,7,8 and building 9&10.' Maths will focus on addition, subtraction and building our number bonds to 5 and then to 10. We will also look at Tangrams and how some shapes fit inside others.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Topic  	<p>This term we will ask the question 'Who will help Mr Wolf make pancakes?'. We will look at the story and think about why the characters might not help the wolf. Within this theme we will explore where the characters live, the contrast between living in the town and city.</p> <p>We will also read the story of 'Mama Panya's pancakes' and look at what it is like to live in other countries. We will learn about similarities and differences between ourselves and others.</p>
Art & Music 	In Art, we will focus on 'Making art with our bodies', Thinking about how we can move our bodies in response to music, stories and art work. We will be taking part in some collaborative art work, painting with our hands and feet.
P.E and Jigsaw 	Our PE lessons will focus on gymnastics, creating and following gymnastic routines. We will be learning how to keep ourselves healthy and look after our bodies, healthy food and sleep choices.
