### **Class Text**

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p>In writing, we will develop our skills to use descriptive vocabulary, paragraphs and past tenses to write a story in first person.</p> <p>In reading, we will continue to develop our reinforcing skills for answering questions linked to the text we are reading.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In Maths we will be learning fractions, looking at numerators and denominators and introducing non-unit and equivalent fractions. In Maths, we will be consolidating our understanding of fractions. We will learn about non-unit and equivalent fractions.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>During the term the we will be learning about light and shadows. We will begin to understand why light helps us to see and that the light from the sun can be dangerous and how to protect our eyes from it.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>During our computing lessons we explore how 'text' and 'images' can be used to communicate messages. We will use desktop publishing software and consider careful choices of font size, colour and type to edit and improve premade documents.</p>

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>Geography</b></p> 	<p>This half term, pupils will learn about the UK, using compass directions to locate places and identify key topographical features such as hills, mountains, coasts and rivers.</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>In RE, we will continue to investigate how and why people pray. We will explore similarities and differences between how Christians, Muslims and Hindus pray and consider the significance of prayers in the lives of people today.</p>
<p><b>DT</b></p> 	<p>In DT, we will investigate different ways to make card shapes three dimensional, e.g. folding and curving the card or joining the flat shapes together.</p> <p>We will plan and design an abstract sculpture based on play equipment. Then, we will combine different shapes together to make an interesting free-standing sculpture.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>We will continue developing our Dance and Gymnastics skills, focusing on rhythm and coordination in Dance, and building core strength and balance through shapes, rolls and sequences in Gymnastics.</p>
