Reading

History of the NHS



ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English we will be writing a biography of Aneurin Bevan and looking at key NHS figures focusing on the chronological life story, significance and contributions to the NHS. We will also be writing a formal letter to a newspaper praising him and explaining NHS values. Reading we will be looking at a variety of texts relating to the NHS in the past.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths we will be completing our work on area and perimeter by finding the area of rectangles and compound shapes. In statistics, we will be learning to read, draw and interpret line graphs and to use tables and timetables. We will be recognising 2D and 3D shapes and finding angles. We will be plotting coordinates and using translation, reflection and symmetry.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>During the term we will be learning about 'Animals including humans'. We will learn to describe the changes as humans develop to old age. We will draw a timeline to indicate stages in the growth and development of humans. We will compare the changes that take place to boys and girls during puberty. We will be comparing the gestation periods and life expectancies of animals.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>In this unit, we will create vector drawings. Learn how to use different drawing tools to help create images. Recognise that images in vector drawings are created using shapes and lines, and each individual element in the drawing is called an object.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>We will find out about the story of the Exodus, sequencing key events and considering different interpretations. We will investigate the ten commandments, considering why the People of God were given these and what they mean for believers today.</p>

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>This term we will be focusing on the history of the NHS and learning about the reformation and how it has developed into the NHS we have today. We will be looking at significant figures during this time and how their work has helped shape the NHS that we currently have. We will learn about the different roles and the part that the NHS plays in today's world.</p>
<p>ART</p> 	<p>In Art we will be exploring domestic architecture. We will use our sketchbooks to collect, record and reflect on ideas and thoughts. We will explore how line, form, structure, material, and scale are all used to make architecture interesting. We will then make an architectural model.</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>In Music we will be focusing on Motown music. We will listen and appraise 'Dancing in the Street' by Martha and The Vandellas. We will learn to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>In PE this term we will be focusing on striking and fielding in rounders. We will be developing throwing and catching skills and bowling under pressure. We will develop striking a bowled ball with increasing consistency and fielding skills. We will then apply these skills and tactics in a game.</p>
<p>SPANISH</p> 	<p>Year 5 will be continuing our MFL journey with Spanish. We will be finding out about sports. We will be using imperative verbs to give game instructions and translate written instructions for the Mayan ball game.</p>
