ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In writing, we will develop our skills to use descriptive vocabulary, paragraphs and past tenses to write a story in first person. In reading, we will continue to develop our reinforcing skills for answering questions linked to the text we are reading.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, We will be continuing learning about partitioning and comparing decimal numbers. Then we will move onto consolidating our learning about money and time.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>In Science, we will continue our learning about sound and volume, then move onto electrical circuits, concentrating on how to build a working circuit and how to be safe when working with electricity.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>During our computing lessons, we will be learning about photo editing, how to do edit photos and considering the reasons behind why people want to edit photo, including thinking about links to mis and dis information.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>During our topic lessons we will continue to develop our skill of using atlases to locate Peterborough and Hunstanton. We will learn about human and the physical differences and similarities between the two places.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>In R.E, We will focus on the religions Christianity, Judaism and Humanism to help us answer the questions 'How can we learn from religions about deciding right from wrong?'</p>
<p>Music and D.T</p> 	<p>In DT, we will be designing and building our own pavilion, learning what makes a sturdy, safe structure and then we will evaluate our structures. In Music, we will be composing music with our friends, working together collaboratively to produce a harmonic piece of music.</p>
