Reading

CONTINENTS & OCEANS

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English, our text for this term is The Secret Sky Garden. We will be using this text to write a diary entry and instructions. We will learn the different features required and use what we have learnt to write our own diary entry.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be learning how to measure in centimetres, metres, grams and kilograms. We learn how to compare and order different lengths, heights and weights. We will also be using maths operations to solve problems with length, height and weights. We will also begin to practise using fractions (half, quarters and thirds).</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>In Science, we will be learning about Habitats around the World. We will identify that most living things live in a habitat to which they are suited and describe how these different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals. We will also think about what humans can do to help reduce the impact humans have on a habitat.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>In Computing this term, learners will listen to a variety of pieces of music and consider how music can make them think and feel. Learners will compare creating music digitally and non-digitally. Learners will look at patterns and purposefully create music.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>In RE, we will focus on what it means to belong to a faith community. We will revisit knowledge from prior units about Muslims, Christians and Jewish people, considering how members of these communities show that they belong.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography</p> 	<p>In Geography, we will name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries as well as other countries, continents and oceans.</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>Friendship Song is a song about being friends. It teaches us about friendship - How are we kind to our friends? Are we kind to new people that come to our school? Embracing the fact that we are all different and knowing that that is brilliant - Let's celebrate that! Learning how to be respectful of one another, wherever we are from, wherever we live and whomever we love.</p>
<p>Art</p> 	<p>In Art, we will be exploring how music and media can influence artistic expression. The children will learn how to pace their focus and drawing skills to the sound metronome. The children will also learn how different sounds can represent different colours through studying the work of Wassily Kandinsky.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>In this unit, pupils develop their understanding of the principles of defending (fielding) and attacking (batting) when playing striking and fielding games. They will use and develop skills such as throwing and catching, tracking a ball and striking a ball. They will learn how to score points, how to play to the rules and use simple tactics. They will learn the importance of showing respect towards others when playing competitively and develop communication skills.</p>
