**Extreme Earth**

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p>This term we will be completing a Descriptive explanation piece of writing explaining How a tornado forms or Describing an earthquake. We will also be writing a narrative with a focus: Building tension and atmosphere related to natural disasters.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be adding and subtracting decimals, and multiply and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. We will be learning to understand, compare and order negative numbers. We will find the difference between negative numbers. We will be converting unit of length, weight and time. We will be comparing and estimating volume and capacity.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>During the term, we will be learning about 'Properties of Materials'. We will learn about reversible and irreversible changes. We will use our knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>This term we will learn about 'Selection in Quizzes' . We will learn how selection is used in computer programs. We will design, create and evaluate a program which uses selection.</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>This term pupils will think carefully about actions, sources of authority, values, religious and non-religious worldviews. They will consider what it means to follow a moral code; carefully thinking about why this might be both helpful and difficult.</p>

<p><b>Geography</b></p> 	<p>In Geography, we will be learning about key aspects of physical geography, focusing on climate zones and understand how human and physical processes interact to influence and change landscapes, environments, and the climate.</p>
<p><b>DT</b></p> 	<p>In DT this term, we will be focusing on gears and pulleys. We will learn how gears and pulleys work and their purpose. During the term the children will design and make a gear and pulley system.</p>
<p><b>Music</b></p> 	<p>In Music, we will be focusing on classical music. We will listen and appraise a variety of music. We will learn about composers and their compositions. We will learn to sing, play, improvise and compose songs. We will consolidate the learning that has occurred during the year.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>In PE this term we will be focusing on Athletics . We will be learning about pace, speed, fluency and coordination when running for speed. We will build momentum and power in the triple jump and develop throwing with force for longer distances.</p>
<p><b>SPANISH</b></p> 	<p>Year 5 will be continuing our MFL journey with Spanish. We will be finding out about Saving South America. We will create campaign adverts to raise awareness of environmental problems in South America and how to solve them.</p>
