ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

English 	In English this term, we will be focusing on retrieval skills needed for answering questions linked to our text "Riddle of the runes" by Janina Ramirez. We will be writing to entertain by writing a narrative, including a setting description about Viking Britain. We will be writing a Non-Chronological Report about the <i>Life as a viking</i>.
Maths 	In Maths, we will be learning place value up to a 6 digit number and how to solve the four operations using their formal methods. Then we will be applying this knowledge while solving problems.
Science 	During the term, the children will be learning about Forces. We will be completing various investigations and learning how to make a test fair.
Computing 	This term, we will learn how to share information on a computer system and network. We will continue learning about E-safety and how to stay safe when using all types of technology.
	This term, we will learn about what Christians believe God is like, explore key texts from the Bible. We will learn how to use vocabulary such as 'omnipotent, omniscient and eternal'.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Geography and History 	In History will be place the Vikings on a timeline. We will investigate why the Vikings left Scandinavia and came to Britain. We will understand what the Vikings' achievements were and how they influenced Britain and the world. In Geography we will identify on a map where the Vikings came from and use modern maps to identify settlements with Viking origins.
Art 	In Art, we will be learning to use typography - creating and arranging letters and words on a page to help communicate ideas or emotions. We will use techniques learnt to create a visual maps.
Music 	In Music, we will be focusing on the song 'Be my friend'. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song. We will listen and appraise songs.
P.E. 	This term we will be developing our skills in hockey and netball. We will learn and develop our skills including dribbling and shooting. This will including learning about defence and working as a team.
MFL 	Year 5 will be continuing our MFL journey with Spanish. We will be learning about describing family and friends giving basic information about people.
