Class Text

Reading

The children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home. The children will have a levelled reader that will be changed on a **Thursday**. They will also have a reading for pleasure book that they can change whenever they wish. Both can be commented on in their reading diary.

PE

PE will take place on a **Tuesday** and **Friday**. Children may come to school in their kit on PE days. They will be wearing this kit outside at lunch and playtimes so please ensure it is weather appropriate.

Homework

Our homework will be sent out every **Friday** returning back into school by the following **Tuesday**. If you have any questions about the homework, please ask.

Please ensure your child brings in a named water bottle everyday.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

English 	In reading we will be using our phonics to help us read simple sentences. We will also be learning a poem to recite from memory and perform to an audience. In writing we will be writing simple sentences ensuring that we use full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. We will have daily phonics lessons to support both reading and writing.
Maths 	In Maths we will be focusing on place value, including sorting objects into sets, counting out a small set from a larger group, ordering numbers and number correspondence. We will also be comparing numbers including using $<$ $>$ and $=$. We will then move onto addition and subtraction.
Science 	In Science we will be exploring seasonal change. We will learn to name the four seasons in order and describe the typical weather in each. We will explore events linked to each season and how daylight changes over a year. We will record data about the temperature across the four seasons and use the information we find to answer questions.
Computing 	In computing we will look at what technology is and how it can help us. We will look at the different components of a computer developing keyboard and mouse skills. We will learn how to use technology safely.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Geography 	In Geography we will think about the fact that we live in a city called Peterborough and learn to locate it on a map. We will start to learn our address. We will talk about our journey to and from school and make a simple map to show what features we pass including different types of houses.
R.E. 	In RE this term we will be learning about some of the key beliefs of Christians. We will look at some of the key beliefs about God and Jesus. We will also look at some of the stories that shows what Christians believe about God.
DT/Art 	In art we will be exploring drawing different lines by varying control and pressure, e.g. straight, wavy, zig zags, broken, lighter, darker etc. We will start to notice 2D shapes within objects and drawings and explore the work of the artist Paul Klee
P.E. 	Our PE will focus on ball skills. We will explore and develop fundamental ball skills such as throwing and catching, rolling and dribbling with both hands and feet. We will develop control and accuracy in our moves.
